### **Children Were Missing and Were Found**

On the 27<sup>th</sup> at Shoreline Beach, twelve children were reported missing after a group of campers came to the beach. The children had wandered out in to the water. There, across a gap of at least twenty yards, were the children. They cheered faintly from hunger. Thirst was quenched from a little fountain nearby. Some had fainted.

The adults tied the ladders together. Throwing a rock with rope across, they made a pulley to drag across the ladders. One at a time the children crawled across the ladders over to the adults. It is almost like climbing monkey bars only you are above them, not hanging from them [that I have never done, at least from my memory, I haven't]. In the end, they rescued the children. Mr. Forester and the Beach Wardens are deciding to build a bridge over the ravine, only in such a way that it isn't carried off by the tide, like the first one they built.

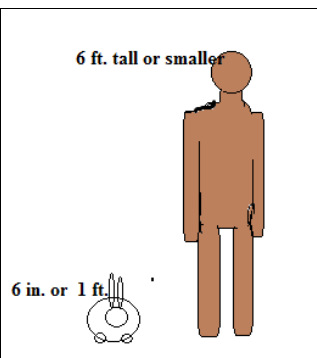
by the Govenor of Pear County. Arnold D. Hamstrings was arrested and put in jail for 20 years.

## MANUEL FOR VOTING IN THE PRIMARIES AND THE ELECTION

1. This is the *advised* voting form. If you are voting at home you must send in your votes so that they will arrive at the end of August for the primaries and the end of November for the election. Each stuffed animal can vote *twice* for anyone who is running. Example:

1. Animal#1 votes for Mr. Blank#1  
Animal#1 votes for Mr. Blank#2
2. Animal#2 votes for Mr. Blank#3  
Animal#2 votes for Mr. Blank#3

The each stuffed animal can vote for the same person twice or put one vote for one person and another for a different person. Each animal can vote twice and *no more* than twice. The reason why we do this is so that the stuffed animal plays as if it is two different people. Please put the votes on *individual* papers.

- If you vote at home make sure you count **CORRECTLY** how many votes each person got and *send* in the number of votes the persons got in to the newspaper. Example:

Person#1 \_\_\_\_\_ votes  
Person#2 \_\_\_\_\_ votes  
Person#3 \_\_\_\_\_ votes

2.If you are voting by phone, you should do the same thing for voting at home except you tell the person who the animal is voting for.



The voting can begin for the primaries on the first of August. Make sure the votes are counted up correctly and sent in so that they can be received by the end of August.

The voting can begin for the election on the first of October. Make sure that the votes are counted up correctly and sent in so that they can be received before November 4<sup>th</sup> which is Election Day!

The results will be shown in the newspaper.

If there is a tie, we will *redo* the voting again and add the second amount of votes to the tied number.

Example:

Person#1 has 33 votes and Person#2 has 33 votes.

-We will redo the voting and add

Person#1- 33 votes

+64 votes

=97 votes

Person#2- 33 votes

+54 votes

=87 votes

Person#1 won.

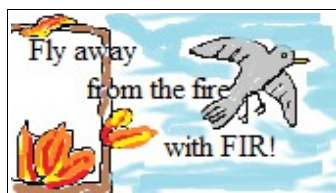
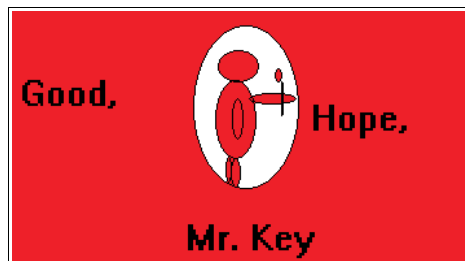

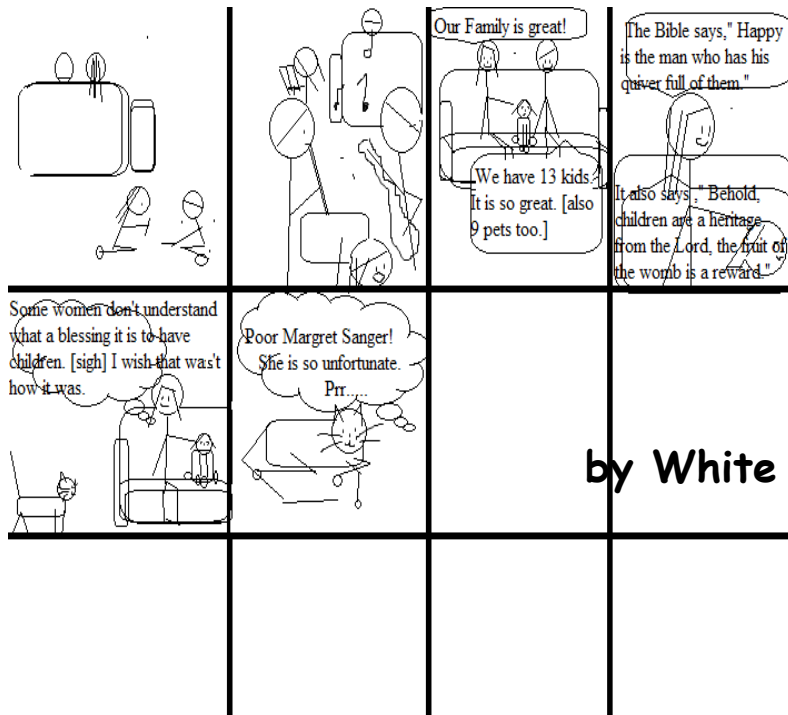
## Mr. Fir's Speech

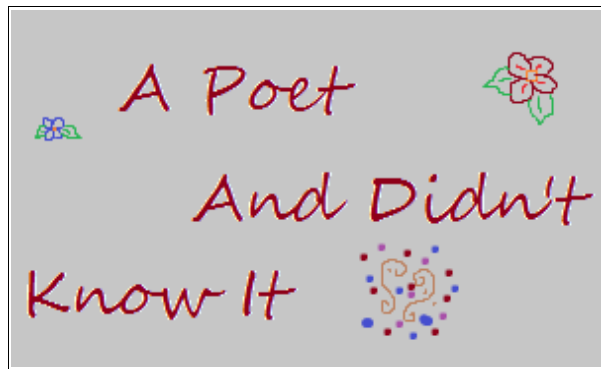
